 Intergovernmental Standards-setting Body established by FAO and WHO in 1961/63;

176 Member Countries + 1 Member Organization (European Community)

Codex Alimentarius Commission - its mandate -

- Dual objective:
 - Protecting the health of consumers
 - Facilitating fair practices in food trade
- Non-mandatory in nature, Codex standards and related texts have become international benchmarks for harmonization under the SPS and TBT Agreements of WTO

C O D E X A L I M E N T A R I U S Organizational Chart






